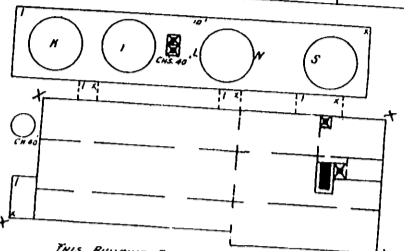

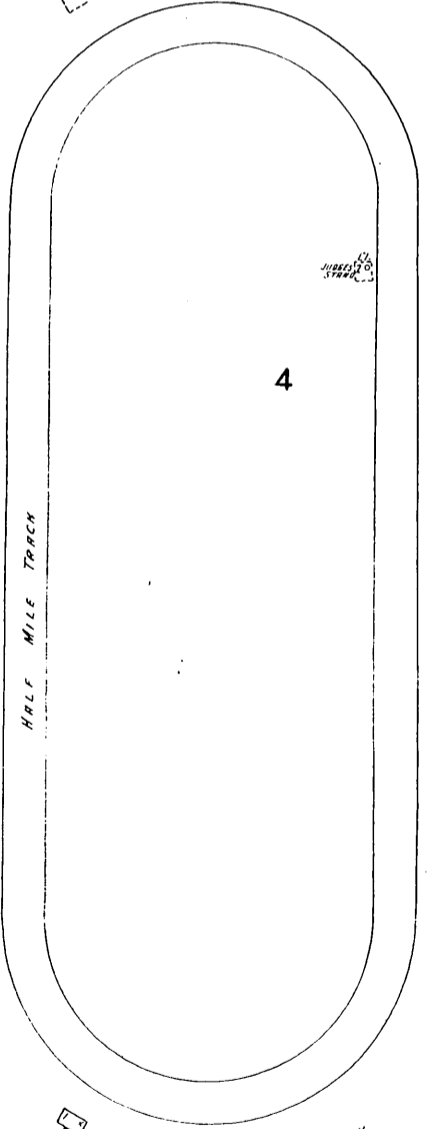


THIS BUILDING FROM X TO X WAS DESTROYED

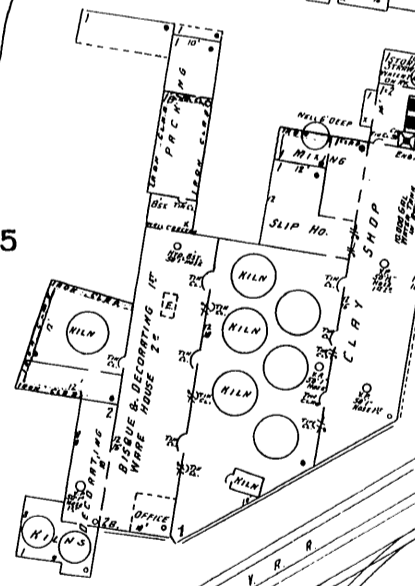

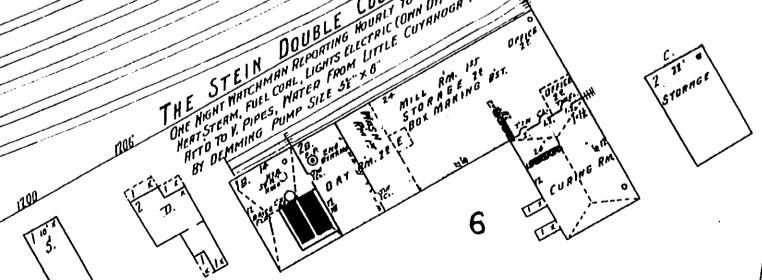
