FIRE DEPARTMENT Paid. 214 men. 20 Steam Fire Engines in service and 1 in reserve. 2 Hose Carts to each of 17 Engines, and 1 Hose Wagon to each of the remaining 3. 1 Hose Company. 3 Chemical Companies. 7 Hook and Ladder Trucks. 100 Horses in service and several others kept in Reserve. 40,000 feet of 2½ in. Hose in good condition. 282 Fire Alarm Telegraph Boxes. 12 Signal Circuits. 10 Alarm Circuits. Each Engine House is connected with the Central Station by Telephone by a direct wire, as is also the **UNDERWRITERS' SALVAGE CORPS**, which has 2 men on duty constantly, and 2 others that attend all fires. 1 Horse and Wagon and 22 Covers.
