WATER FACILITIES. Pumping station 3 miles North of City Hall. Two Deane Pumps, capacity 2 million gals per 24 hours. Stand water 20' - 100' base of same 40ft above ganchusky & Williams. Sids Water supply from one flowing well 5' x 20" and one well 25' x 30" filled through gravel bed from river. 20 Miles of water pipes 4" to 16". 225 Double hydrants. Domestic pressure 60 lbs. fire pressure 125 lbs. Average daily consumption 125,000 galls. 16 Public fire cisterns.

FIRE DEPARTMENT. 4 Paid men. 12 Volunteers. 6 Horses. Fire alarm by bell on City Hall, and by telephone system. One second class Silsby steam fire engine. One hook & ladder truck. One 100 gall chemical engine. One hose wagon. 3000 ft. 2½" good hose. Grades undulating, streets partly macadamized. Lights - electric gas & kero oil.
