WATER FACILITIES:

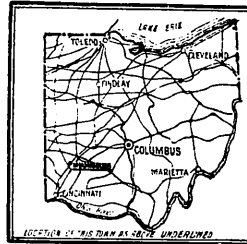
Municipal Water Works direct pressure system. Water supply from five 8' driven wells, about 65 ft. deep. 1.0 laidlaw - Dunn - Gordon cross compound horizontal pumps (24-26-5-18) copy 12 million galls. each per 24 hours. 12 miles of water pipes, 4" to 14" diam. Original mains laid in 1904 in double hydrants. One triple hydrant. Domestic pressure 10 to 15 lbs. fire pressure 10 lbs. Average daily consumption 500,000 galls.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Volunteer, three paid men. 11 partly paid men. One driver on constant duty. One Grinnell-Bernstein auto combination hose & chemical truck with 40 gall. chem. tank 150 ft. chem. hose 3500 ft. 24' cotton rubber lined hose, and 3 hard chem. extinguishers. One hook & ladder truck. One combination hose & chem. wagon and one Ahrens - Fox 24 class steam fire engine in reserve. Fire alarm by telephone and water works whistle. No fire limits.

Grades level. Principal streets paved with brick, others graded. Public lights electric.
